
Homecoming Tailgating Policies and Procedures

___ **Hours:** The campus will be open to visitors at 10:00 AM, and will close to visitors at 10:00 PM.

___ **Parking:** Parking costs \$5 for general admission, and \$10 for VIP. The map for these areas is included below.

___ **Tent policies:** If you would like to set up a tent, you must submit a Facilities Toolkit at least 10 days prior to the Homecoming game day. Only shade tents without side panels will be permitted.

___ **Greek Row & Alumni Organizations:** NPHC & MGC Fraternities and Sororities will each have a designated area in the VIP section. These areas will be clearly marked with each organization's shield. Other organizations that have active alumni may petition for a designated area in the VIP section. This petition must be made at least 10 days prior to the Homecoming game day, using the Tailgate Reservation Application Form (attached below). ___ **Reserved VIP Tailgating Locations:** Visitors who would like to ensure that they have a spot in the VIP area may submit a Tailgate Reservation Application Form. There is no charge to submit a form, and requests will be granted on a first-come first-serve basis. There will be no guarantees related to a particular location within the VIP area. Also, any visitor who has not checked into their spot by 12:00 noon will forfeit their reservation.

___ **Alcohol Policy:** Current Paul Quinn students are not permitted to consume alcohol on campus, under any circumstances, at any time. Students in violation of this policy will be subject to disciplinary actions, up to and including expulsion. Consumption of beer and wine will be allowed for visitors during visitor hours on Homecoming day in the designated tailgating areas ONLY, in accordance with all applicable state and municipal laws in governing the City of Dallas and the State of Texas. It is the responsibility of the server and the consumer to be aware of and in compliance with these laws. Serving alcohol to persons under the age of 21 is a violation of state law, as is consumption and possession of alcohol for those under the age of 21. Responsible and appropriate behavior is expected when consuming alcohol on campus. Those who fail to meet these standards may lose tailgating privileges, asked to leave campus, and/or face sanctions from law enforcement personnel.

___ **Food Preparation Policy:** Propane and charcoal grills will be the only permitted means of food preparation, and hot coals must be completely extinguished with water before leaving the tailgating site. No food is to be sold.

___ **Security and health support:** The staff of Paul Quinn College are making every effort to keep our students and visitors safe and healthy during Homecoming. Medical and security personal will be present throughout the day. If you find yourself in need of security or health support, please call the main security booth at (214) 379-5599. If you are in an emergency situation, please call 911.

___ **Release of Liability:** Visitors voluntarily assume all risk of personal injury incidental to the Homecoming event, including the risk of lost, stolen or damaged property. The college may revoke a parking license or visitor status and eject or refuse entry to anyone it deems in violation of venue rules, illegal activity, misconduct or failure to comply with any and all security measures.

___ **Vendors:** No vendors are permitted to sell PQC paraphernalia without prior approval from the college. College-endorsed merchandise will be available for purchase in the gym during the homecoming basketball games.
